The minimum requirement for running the system is a PC with 64MB RAM, a Pentium II 350 Mhz processor and a high speed disk running under Windows 95, 98 or NT workstations and local area network supporting Windows. It also requires a Windows supported printer. If image data is exported regularly, then a writable CD is recommended.

You will also need the following installed: Microsoft Word 7/97, SR2a and Internet Explorer 4 or 5.
